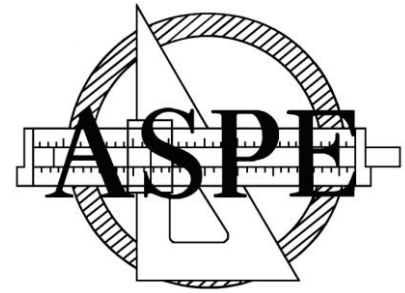
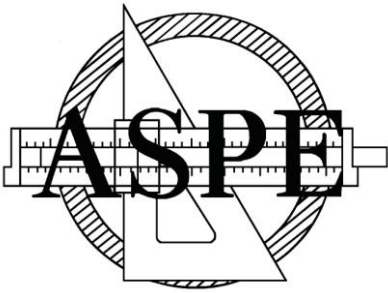

The theme for this year's DFW ASPE Product Show is "Green Building Design and Technology." In keeping with this, we are seeking out plumbing engineers, designers and industry professionals with experience in "Green" Technology and Sustainable Building Systems Design who will share their expertise and participate as presenters in the technical program portion of the day's events. The 2009 DFW ASPE Product Show Technical Presentations will be held from 12:30 to 4:30 p.m. on the day of the show.

SAMPLE SUBJECT TOPICS:

- Plumbing Systems for Green and Sustainable Building Design
- Green Retrofits
- Water Recycling Systems and Uses for Gray Water, Black Water, and Storm Water
- Solar Water Heating/Preheating Applications in Design
- Emerging Technologies in Sustainable Plumbing Design

PROPOSAL SUBMITTALS:

Provide for each topic proposal submittal a 200- to 400-word narrative describing the proposed seminar or workshop. Information provided in the narrative should include:

- How the program will enhance the knowledge and skill sets of the professional plumbing engineer/designer.
- What practical professional skills will be enhanced.
- How the session attendee and his/her employer will benefit directly.

Presentations must be nonproprietary in nature, as the technical sessions are about education.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

The presentation program should include an introduction to the topic to be discussed; relevant terms, definitions, formulas, codes and regulatory guidelines; descriptions of system equipment, components and materials; and specifications. The program should discuss the objectives of the system design and relative parameters. The program should incorporate at least one realistic design scenario with a step-by-step solution.

Presenters should be prepared to provide appropriate guidance and leadership and to answer questions from the attendees.

All presentations should have relevant handout material that includes all information presented, including visual materials used and documentation of sample design problem(s) presented.

Presentations will be limited to 50 minutes in length to allow for breakdown and setup while attendees take a short break between presentations. Presenters will need to be ready to plug in any equipment and present without technical difficulties.

BIOGRAPHY OF PRESENTER:

Please include a brief one-page, 200-word biography with each proposal. Include any prior seminar experience with topic(s) presented. Also, please provide contact information, including e-mail address and daytime telephone number(s). Inclusion of a photo is also helpful.

PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL DATE:

Proposals submitted for consideration should be received no later than Sept. 1, 2009. Proposals may be submitted in hard-copy form or electronically (preferred).
